Archaeological Evaluation at Baynes Street / St. Pancras Way, London N.W.1

**Abstract** The earliest feature recorded on the site was the fireplace or hearth, probably of 13th to 15th century date. It was truncated, and no contemporary building remains were found. It was not possible to determine the nature of the structure that the feature was part of, and therefore not possible to confirm that it was part of Cantelow Manor, which is supposed to be in the vicinity. Further excavation in adjacent areas was recommended.
